1. Was it possible to achieve a complete tumour resection?

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5. When is the next control MRI scheduled?

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2. When can I expect the result of the biopsy to be ready?

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6. In which sequences do I have to have an MRI, CT or PET scan from now on?

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3. What does the result of the surgery imply for me? What is my prognosis?

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7. Who is going to be leading the control examinations?

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4. What happens next – are there any further therapies?

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8. Who is my future contact person?

9. When will I be able to work again? How about sports?

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13. Is the therapy going to be conducted out- or inpatient?

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10. Do I need a subsequent therapy after surgery?

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14. Which side effects might occur and how should I handle those?

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11. How much time is going to pass between surgery and after care?

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15. Can I enhance the outcome of my therapy in any way?

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12. Which therapies should I try? What are their special advantages?

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16. How long will the continuative therapy take and what is going to happen when the continuative therapy is completed?
